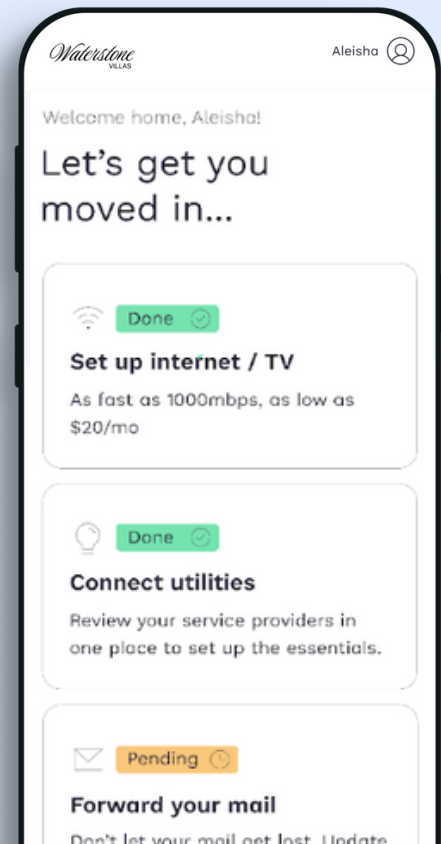
Emails and spreadsheets weren't invented to manage move-ins. With Updater Pro, your future residents can complete all moving-related tasks in one place.

01 | Set Up Your Property Details

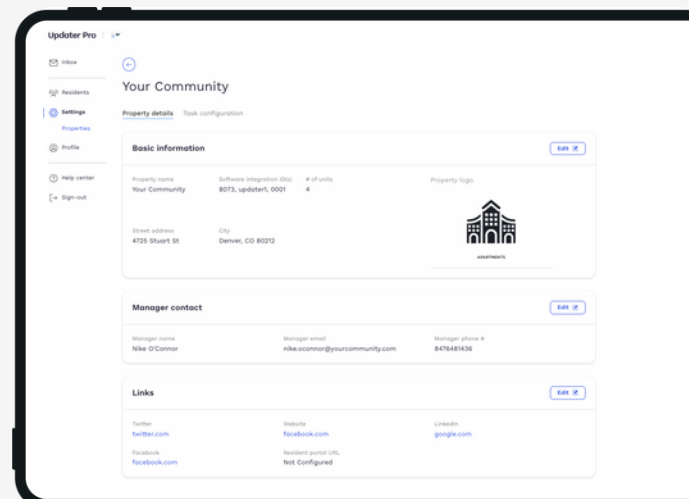
Look for an email from Updater with your community's log-in details

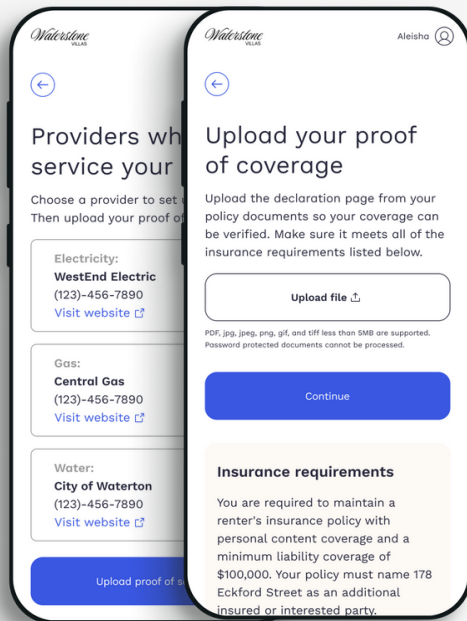
